PROPOSALS

Proposal number one, an amendment

Amendment to Protect Against Unequal Treatment

This proposal would protect against unequal treatment based on ethnicity, national origin, age, disability, and sex, including sexual orientation, gender identity and pregnancy. It also protects against unequal treatment based on reproductive healthcare and autonomy.

A "YES" vote puts these protections in the New York State Constitution.

A "NO" vote leaves protections out of the State Constitution.

1. Mark the oval to the left of the name of your choice. 
2. To vote for a candidate whose name is not printed on the ballot, print the name clearly in the box labeled "Write-In", staying within the box.
3. Any mark or writing outside the spaces provided for voting may void the entire ballot.

4. To vote on a question or proposal, mark the oval below your choice.
5. The number of choices is listed for each contest.
6. Do not mark the ballot for more candidates than allowed. If you do, your vote in that contest will not count.

7. If you tear, deface or wrongly mark this ballot, return it to a poll worker and obtain another. Do not attempt to correct mistakes on the ballot by making erasures or cross-outs. Erasures or cross-outs may invalidate all or part of your ballot. Prior to submitting your ballot, if you make a mistake in completing the ballot or wish to change your ballot choices, you may obtain and complete a new ballot. You have a right to a replacement ballot upon the return of the original ballot.
8. After completing your ballot, insert it into the ballot scanner and wait for the notice that your ballot has been successfully scanned. If no such notice appears, seek assistance of an election inspector.

How to mark and cast your ballot

For Early Voting or Election Day in person voters:

1. Mark the oval to the left of the name of your choice.
2. Any mark or writing outside the spaces provided for voting may void the entire ballot.
3. The number of choices is listed for each contest.
4. Do not mark the ballot for more candidates than allowed. If you do, your vote in that contest will not count.
5. If you make a mistake, or want to change your vote, ask a poll worker for a new ballot.
6. Cast you marked ballot on the voting machine at your poll site; wait for the machine to indicate “Successfully Cast.”



For an Early Mail, Absentee, Military or UOCAVA voters:

1. Mark the oval to the left of the name of your choice.
2. Any mark or writing outside the spaces provided for voting may void the entire ballot.
3. The number of choices is listed for each contest.
4. Do not mark the ballot for more candidates than allowed. If you do, your vote in that contest will not count.
5. You have a right to a replacement ballot. If you make a mistake or want to change your vote, call the County Board of Election at (585) 396-4005 for instructions on how to obtain a new ballot.
6. After marking the ballot, fold such ballot and enclose it in the envelope bearing the voter's statement, and seal the envelope.
7. Fill in properly the blanks in the statement and sign your name.
8. Enclose the sealed envelope bearing the statement in the envelope addressed to the County Board of Elections and mail promptly.
9. To be counted, absentee ballots returned by mail must be postmarked by the day of the election and be received by the County Board of Elections no later than 7 days after election day.
